The Ralph Fehland Award: Monee Citizen of The Year was started to honor its namesake, who was himself a lifelong Monee resident. Mr. Fehland served in a variety of roles which contributed to the betterment of our Monee community. He even was elected as Monee Mayor, in addition to serving on The Crete Monee School Board in the 1950s! Mr. Fehland for many years valiantly served as a Monee Fire Department serviceman. Then in the early 1980s, he went on to serve as Fire Department Treasurer.

This award is presented in memoriam annually to an individual who similarly has made a significant volunteer contribution to the betterment of the community in the last year.
