This award is presented to an individual that has made a significant volunteer contribution to the betterment of their community in the last year. Nominations are reviewed by the Monee Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors. The Board of Directors considers the following criteria in their selection process:

1. Business community service, i.e., chamber, economic developments, etc.
2. Civic community service, i.e. city council, fire, school, county, park, forest preserve, library board
3. Church community service
4. Service organizations, i.e. Lions, Kiwanis, 4-H, Women's Club, Girl/Boy Scouts, etc.

Members of the community are encouraged to submit recommendations for this award with a letter stating why they believe the person should be considered for the award based on the criteria listed above and any additional information they feel is valuable.

Candidate's letter of recommendation should be mailed to the Monee Chamber of Commerce by April 7, 2023.
